

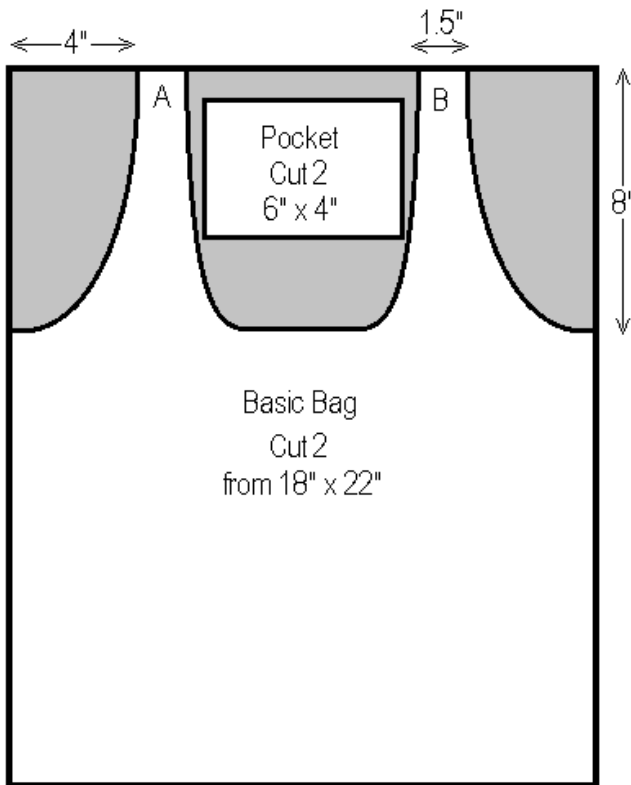

 Fabric quantities based on 42"/115cm width sometimes wider depending on the fabrics.
 No allowance made for pre-washing fabric
 WOF = width of fabric.
 We allow a small amount for straightening the edge for cutting.
 Always measure twice and cut once.

Basic Folding Shopping Bag

Supplies:

- 2 Fat Quarters or .45m fabric
- Thread to Match
- Bias Binding (optional) Approx. 2m



- All measurements are approximate, no need to be fussy!
- 1) Cutting through two layers, use the diagram as a guide to create your bag and pocket pieces.
 - 2) Hem the top of one pocket piece.
 - 3) With right sides together, sew or serge the sides and bottom seams of both the bag and the pocket.
 - 4) Turn the pocket right side out and attach the unfinished edge to one side of the bag between the handles. The pocket should end up right side out on the inside of the bag.
 - 5) There are two options for the handles: You may attach A to B (if you are using two different fabrics, this would be the better option); or A to A and B to B.
 - 6) If you are finishing with binding, turn your bag right side out and bind now, otherwise hem your edges.
 - 7) Your bag can fold up inside its pocket to tuck away for when you need it.
